1 – GENERAL CONDITIONS

2.1.5. Hill Climb Historic Trophy AŠ SLO and GHD Regularity

For championships use regulations GHD and Historic.

- 2.2 Safety equipment of all vehicles must be in accordance with FIA Appendix J and K.
- 2.3 Any vehicle not complying with the regulations or with insufficient safety features shall not be admitted to or shall be excluded from the competition.
- 2.4 Only fuel which complies with the provisions of Appendixes J and K may be used.
- 2.5 Any form of pre-heating the tires before the start is strictly prohibited and should be sanctioned. Sanctions can go as far as disqualification from the competition.

3 – DRIVER'S SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- 3.1 It is mandatory to use safety belts, helmets and head restraining devices such as HANS during practice and race heats. All equipment must be in accordance with FIA regulations. For historic vehicles, use of head restraint device, in accordance with FIA regulations, is mandatory for Periods J1 and J2, for TGP and F1 from period G and onwards where the construction of the vehicle makes it practical to do so and it is recommended for other historic cars.
- 3.2 It is mandatory for all drivers to wear flame-resistant clothing (including the overall, a mask or balaclava, gloves, undershirts, shoes, socks etc.,) which must be in accordance with the FIA standards.

4 – ENTRIES, LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

- 4.1 With the entry form the driver accepts this Supplementary Regulations. Entry forms must be sent to:

CLOSING OF ENTRIES: 25.06.2025 at 24.00 h

- 4.2 Vehicle can be changed after the closing of entries, but only if the new vehicle belongs to the same group and same cylinder capacity (Art. 3.2) as the vehicle that is being replaced.
- 4.3 No change of competitor is possible after the closure of entries. Change of competitor is possible in accordance with Art121 ISC. Replacement driver, who must have a valid driving license or licenses as well as his/her ASN start permit, must be named before his/her administrative check.
- 4.4 Double start (1 driver for 2 vehicles or 1 vehicle for 2 drivers) is not permitted.
- 4.5 Entry fees shall be as follows:
 - International race **modern vehicles 350 €; historic vehicles 250 €.**
 - For **Austrian** drivers (modern vehicles): **300 €**, For Austrian drivers (historic vehicles) **250 €.**
 - Drivers that have a valid license of AŠ SLO – Zveza za avtošport Slovenije, must pay the entry

fee in accordance to the Tender for the Open National Championship of Slovenia and Trophy Cups AŠ SLO for the year 2025.

- Without the organizer's optional advertising competitor must pay **double entry fee**.

4.6 Entries shall be accepted only if the entry fees are received by the deadline, set in Article 4.1. Organizing committee reserves the right to accept entry when the entry fee is paid under the conditions of Article 4.5. and 6 (Administrative checks)

4.7 In accordance with legal requirements the organizer has taken out one or more insurance policies against the following risks:
Third party insurance in the amount of € 8.000.000,00 for the event.
The insurance against the third party is valid for the entire duration of the Competition, not only during practice and race heats but also during traveling from the parking area to the course of the Competition and back.

5– GENERAL OBLIGATIONS

5.1 Flag signals, track behavior

5.1.1 During the official practice and race heats the following signals, which must be strictly observed, shall be used:

Red flag	Immediate and definite stop of your vehicle
Yellow flag*	Danger, absolutely no overtaking
Yellow flag with vertical red stripes	Slippery surface, change in grip
Blue flag	Competitor attempting to overtake
White flag	Officials' vehicle on the track
Black and white cheered flag	End of the heat (finish line)

*** Waving flag**

IMMEDIATE DANGER, BE PREPARED TO STOP

5.1.2 It is strictly prohibited to drive a vehicle across or in the opposite direction of the race, unless instructed to do so by the track marshals or the clerk of the course. Any breach of this regulation shall result in disqualification, with possible addition of other sanctions and the transmission of the case to the ASN concerned.

5.1.3 If a driver is obliged to stop the heat due to mechanical errors or any other problems, he/she must immediately park his/her vehicle away from the track and leave it, and obey the instructions of the track marshals.

6 - ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS AND SCRUTINEERING

6.1 Administrative checks

The driver must report to the checks in person.

6.1.1 The following documents must be presented:

- valid car driving license,
- valid driver's and competitors license,
- valid medical card.

The following documents must be sent together with the entry form:

- double-sided copy of international Competitor's and Driver's licenses,
- extract of the Performance factor sheet (Pf): www.performancefactor.fia.com
- permission from the vehicle's owner, if it is not the driver,
- foreign drivers: starting permit from their ASN,
- historic vehicles: copy of the 1st page of HTP,
- confirmation of paid entry fee,
- signed declaration.

6.2 Scrutineering

The following documents must be presented:

- vehicle technical passport (historic vehicles national or international HTP),
- drivers Cat. 1; 2; extract of Performance factor sheet (PF): www.performancefactor.fia.com
- completed form for vehicle and driver safety equipment.

6.2.1 The drivers are obligated to accompany their vehicle at the scrutineering, so that identification and safety checks can be carried out.

6.2.2 The homologation of the vehicle must be presented on request, otherwise scrutineering may be refused.

7 – RUNNING OF THE COMPETITION

7.1 Start, finish, timekeeping

7.1.1 No vehicle may start outside of their group, unless expressly authorized by the Stewards.

7.1.2 A vehicle that triggered the starting apparatus shall be considered as having started and cannot repeat the start.

7.1.3 Refusal or delay to the start shall result in exclusion from the competition.

7.1.4 The finish shall be a flying finish. The heat is over when the vehicle crosses the finish line. **Immediately after that, the vehicle must reduce speed drastically.**

7.2 Practice

7.2.1 It is strictly prohibited to practice with the competing cars outside of the times, scheduled for the practice.

7.2.2 In order to compete in the race heat, the driver must finish at least one practice heat. Special cases shall be submitted to the panel of the Stewards.

7.3 Race

7.3.1 The Competition shall be run over 2 heats.

7.4 Outside assistance

7.4.1 Any kind of outside assistance shall result in disqualification.

7.4.2 Vehicles which have stopped along the track may be towed away only by the order of the Clerk of the Course.

8 – CLASSIFICATIONS, PROTESTS, APPEALS

APENDIX 1

1. Return from the Parking Area and/or Parc Fermé to the Service Park

Upon returning from the parking area and/or Parc Fermé at the finish to the service park, all drivers are strictly required to wear safety belts.

Wearing crash helmets is mandatory for drivers of single-seater and two-seater racing cars and strongly recommended for drivers of touring cars.

It is strictly prohibited to carry any passengers during the return journey.

During the return journey from the finish to the starting area, drivers must maintain a close convoy formation and avoid leaving excessive space between their vehicle and the one in front.

Any violation of these rules will result in the competitor being reported to the stewards, who may impose appropriate sanctions.

2. Compliance with Officials' Instructions

All drivers must strictly follow the instructions given by race officials.

3. Penalties for Non-Compliance

Failure to comply with these provisions may result in penalties being imposed by the stewards, up to and including exclusion from the competition.

4. Environmental Regulations


Waste oil and other vehicle fluids must be disposed of in designated containers. All drivers are **required to use liquid-tight tarpaulins** under their vehicles, with **minimum dimensions of 3 x 4 meters**. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in a **fine of €150**.

5. Fuel Requirements Before Practice

Before the start of practice, each vehicle must be filled with **sufficient fuel for two full runs and the return trip**.

6. Chicane

One chicane is located on the track, approximately **3190 meters from the start**. The **second row of tire stacks is left open** to allow for an **emergency exit**. In the event of a technical issue or a braking error, drivers may use this **emergency passage** through the chicane. The chicane is constructed in accordance with the official layout on the picture below.



7. Chicane Passage Regulations

To prevent any competitive advantage gained from incorrect passage through the chicane, **every improper crossing will be reported without exception** to the **Clerk of the Course and/or the Stewards**.

Judges of fact will be appointed on-site to monitor compliance.

Any incorrect passage through the chicane will result in a **time penalty of 45 seconds (!)**.

This penalty will be added to the driver's total time in the respective **practice or race session**.
