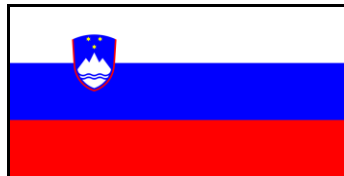

REGULATIONS

The final text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version, which shall be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Article 1 – Organisation

The Competition, which has the status of an International Competition, shall be run in conformity with:

- the International Sporting Code ("the Code") and its Appendices,
- the National Sporting Code where applicable,
- the official FIA Bulletins,
- the General Prescriptions applicable to International Hill Climb Competitions
- the Sporting Regulations of the FIA Historic Hill Climb Championship ("the Sporting Regulations"), and
- these Supplementary Regulations.

Characteristics of the Competition:

c) Any Driver must mandatorily complete at least one practice heat in order to be allowed to start the race. Special cases shall be submitted to the stewards.

d) Driver classifications shall be established by adding together the times of each Driver's 2 best race heats.

Licence requirements:

Drivers: Car driving licence and Grade D International Licence (ITD-R) or Grade C International Licence (ITC-R).

Competitors: International.

National/International Licence Equivalence:

The Organising ASN's National Licence has the same value as an International Licence for the Competition counting towards the FIA Championship only.

The following entry conditions must be respected:

- The Driver has proven experience with the car entered (minimum of [1] previous participations with the same car during the last 24 months)

In order to be taken into consideration, the entry form, duly dated and signed by the Driver and the Competitor, must be sent to the Organiser before the closing date.

Rejections, Withdrawals:

In the event that an entry is rejected or the Competition is cancelled, the entry fees shall be reimbursed in full.

In case of withdrawal for reasons of Force Majeure (no-show for administrative checking and scrutineering) after the publication of the entry list, 50% of the base entry fees shall be reimbursed to the Competitor(s), subject to receipt of a written request.

Article 4 – Obligations of Participants

Competition numbers:

The Organiser shall provide each participant with at least two sets of Competition numbers.

A set of Competition numbers must be clearly displayed on both sides of the car throughout the Competition.

An additional set of Competition numbers (maximum height 15 cm) must be placed on the right side of the windscreen (or, if the car has no windscreen, on a forward-facing part of the car) and on the left side of the rear window.

Vehicles without their correct Competition numbers shall not be allowed to take the start.

Article 6 – Insurance

In accordance with legal requirements, the Organiser has taken out one or more insurance policies against the following risks:

- Third Party Insurance in the amount of €8.000.000 for the event.

- Other:

The Organiser's third party insurance is valid for the entire duration of the Competition, not only during official practice and race heats but also for travelling from the parking area to the course of the Competition and back.

Article 7 – Protests, appeals and Rights of Review

7.1 Protests

Protests must be filed in accordance with Art. 13 ISC.

Amount of the protest deposit: €900.

7.2 Appeals

Appeals must be lodged in accordance with Art. 15 ISC and Art. 14 JDR.

Amount of the appeal fee: €3'000 for organisation or other entity, or €1'000 for natural persons, in accordance with Art. 14.1.2 JDR.

Amount of the appeal deposit: €6'000 for organisation or other entity or €3'000 for natural persons, in accordance with Art. 14.1.2 JDR.

7.3 Right of Review

Petitions for review must be filed in accordance with Art. 14 ISC.

Amount of the right of review deposit: €1'000.

Article 8 – Podium, Prizes and Awards:

8.1 Trophies and Cash prizes

The classifications shall be established and shall entail the distribution by the Organiser of awards and cash prizes as follows:

8.2 Cash prizes and/or special prizes

8.3 Trophies

a) Trophies shall be awarded regardless of the number of Drivers who take the start.

b) All trophies are cumulative and may be combined with one another and with other prizes awarded by the organisers in the other jointly-organised Competitions.

c) Awarding of prizes:

• Trophies are awarded during the podium Ceremony.

APENDIX 1

1. Return from the Parking Area and/or Parc Fermé to the Service Park

Upon returning from the parking area and/or Parc Fermé at the finish to the service park, all drivers are strictly required to wear safety belts.

Wearing crash helmets is mandatory for drivers of single-seater and two-seater racing cars and strongly recommended for drivers of touring cars.

It is strictly prohibited to carry any passengers during the return journey.

During the return journey from the finish to the starting area, drivers must maintain a close convoy formation and avoid leaving excessive space between their vehicle and the one in front.

Any violation of these rules will result in the competitor being reported to the stewards, who may impose appropriate sanctions.

2. Compliance with Officials' Instructions

All drivers must strictly follow the instructions given by race officials.

3. Penalties for Non-Compliance

Failure to comply with these provisions may result in penalties being imposed by the stewards, up to and including exclusion from the competition.

4. Environmental Regulations

Waste oil and other vehicle fluids must be disposed of in designated containers. All drivers are **required to use liquid-tight tarpaulins** under their vehicles, with **minimum dimensions of 3 x 4 meters**. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in a **fine of €150**.

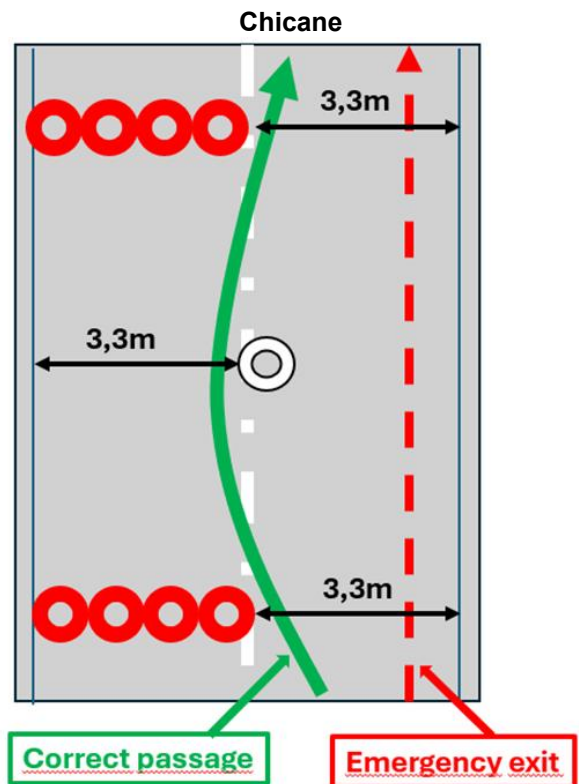
5. Fuel Requirements Before Practice

Before the start of practice, each vehicle must be filled with **sufficient fuel for two full runs and the return trip**.

6. Chicane

One chicane is located on the track, approximately **3190 meters from the start**. The **second row of tire stacks is left open** to allow for an **emergency exit**.

In the event of a technical issue or a braking error, drivers may use this **emergency passage** through the chicane. The chicane is constructed in accordance with the official layout on the picture below.



7. Chicane Passage Regulations

To prevent any competitive advantage gained from incorrect passage through the chicane, **every improper crossing will be reported without exception** to the Clerk of the Course and/or the Stewards.

Judges of fact will be appointed on-site to monitor compliance.

Any incorrect passage through the chicane will result in a **time penalty of 45 seconds (!)**.

This penalty will be added to the driver's total time in the respective **practice or race session**.
